





Birch is one of the most common and fastest growing trees species across the globe. This is why plywood and birch products are affordable and low-cost compared to other wood materials. During any technological processes of woodworking, birch bark is thrown out as an unnecessary component.

The goal of **Berësta** Project is to create the products enabling to turn birch bark from material for craft into a full-fledged material for mass production.

Such birch bark properties as strength, flexibility, water resistance, antibacterial effect, anti-slip properties and incredibly pleasant tactile properties make it possible to ensure high quality of the items manufactured.

The project is being developed under the patronage of the International Centre for Responsible Tourism (Russia and the CIS (Commonwealth of Independent States)), as well as through the cooperation of specialists in different areas: ceramics, illustration, industrial and web design.








small cup

height 7 cm diameter 7 cm material: porcelain, birch bark




large cup

Gramoty



This collection would be a great gift for everyone who cares for Russian history!










Onfim

The image is impressed via hot embossing, which ensures that the picture is not affected by washing and external influences. This collection would be a great creative gift!





































